

Beginning Watercolor Class

MATERIAL LIST

Soft lead pencil 2B

Kneaded eraser

Black Finetip waterproof marker – Micron and Faber Castell - optional brands

Drawing-Sketch paper or pad (8 X 10 or larger)

Palette (plastic or metal with a cover)

Watercolor tube paints (if possible buy artist or professional grade – it will make a difference!)
Daniel Smith brand is a nice option

4 basic colors to start: (different color groupings) – select one group

French ultramarine blue, new gamboge, permanent rose, and burnt sienna

Rose madder genuine, aureolin, cobalt blue and burnt sienna

Permanent alizarin crimson, winsor yellow, winsor blue (phthalo blue) and burnt sienna

Watercolor brush #8 *or* #10 round (make sure it comes to a nice point when wet!)

Watercolor paper **cold press** 9 X 12” or larger (blocks and pads work well)

Water container

Small spray bottle (you will need to keep your paints moist)

Paper towels (Viva is great!)
